SUNDAY

Caribbean partners | The Bahamas, Cuba, The Dominican Republic, Haiti, Jamaica
Churches | Pray for unity and opportunities to offer HOPE to our neighbors. Pray for wisdom for church leaders and that people would come to know Jesus.

MONDAY

Central American partners | Belize, Costa Rica, Mexico
Governments | Pray that leaders at all levels around the world would seek God and the truth found in His Word as their source of wisdom and guidance.

TUESDAY

South American partners | Guyana
Healthcare | The quality of healthcare varies greatly around the world. Pray that God would give strength and healing for the sick and those who may not have access. Pray for doctors and nurses and other healthcare professionals.

WEDNESDAY

Asian partners | Cambodia, India, Nepal, Myanmar
Hunger | Pray that progress would be made towards ending hunger, achieving food security, and improving nutrition. Ask God to raise up advocates and activists who will make a true impact for the millions who face chronic hunger.

THURSDAY

Eastern European partners | Moldova
Education | Pray that children everywhere would have access to education, that their families would value and prioritize learning and that governments would provide the funding needed for important resources.

FRIDAY

Middle Eastern partners | Jordan
Clean Water | Pray that one day clean water would be a reality on a global scale. Pray for the women and children whose daily task it is to walk great distances in order to provide water for their families.

SATURDAY

African partners | Zimbabwe
Sponsored Children | Pray for the children and families that are in our sponsorship programs around the world. Pray for their wellness, education and relationship with God.

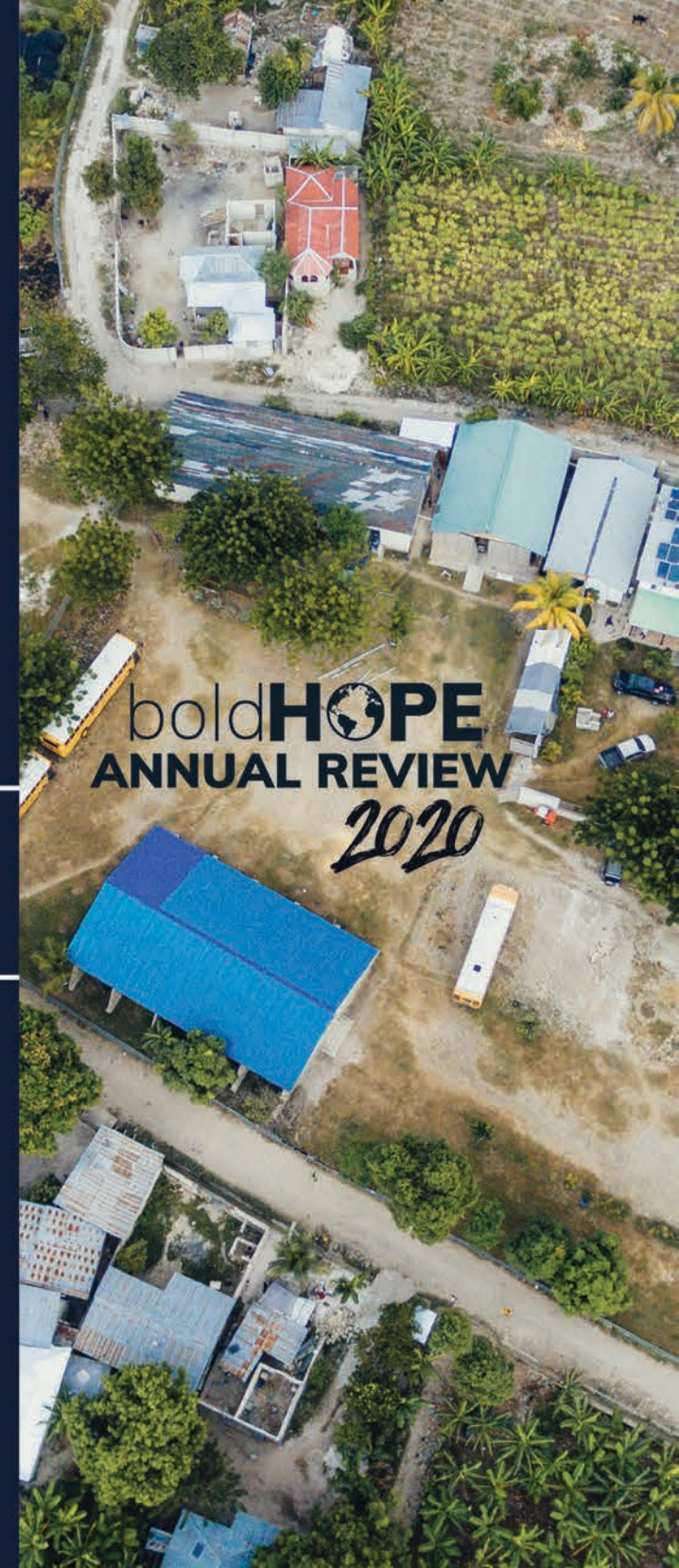

SPONSORSHIP STORY: Nepal

M. (name withheld for her privacy and protection) is a beautiful girl with a beautiful heart. As a young teenager she was trafficked to India. Human trafficking was very common in her village and her mother used to own a brothel in Kolkata, India. M. was rescued and brought back to Nepal where she was accepted into our The Apple of God's Eyes family.

After a few years with us, someone claiming to be her mother's lawyer came, saying that her mom missed her and wanted to reconnect. After the case went through many sectors, it was determined that M could stay where she was since her mother was the person who trafficked her in the first place. Thanks to generous sponsors, The Apple of God's Eyes was able to provide for her and keep her safe, while also teaching her how to sew and bake. Today she is a totally focused and independent person, living with honor and dignity, and dreaming for a brighter future.

Offers formal training for church planters.

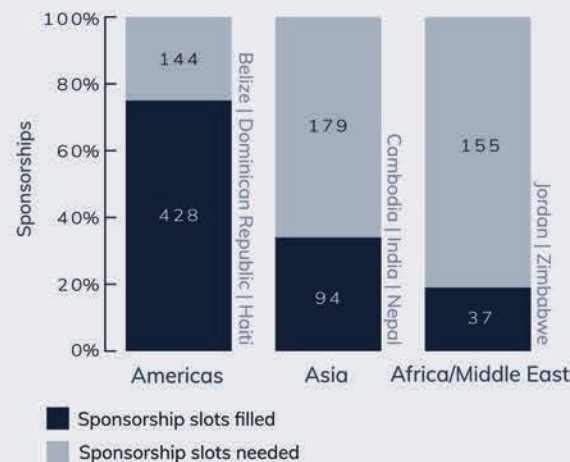


JORDAN | Child Sponsorship
