

- Isaigh 40:28-31


The whole world thought 2021 was going to be better. And maybe it was, marginally. More vaccines were available. Life started to open back up again. And yet... fuel shortages and breaks in supply chains put the cost of food out of reach for many. Schools were still shut down in places where people had no access to the internet. Jobs that were put on hold didn't resume. Unprecedented instability threw nations like Haiti and Zimbabwe into complete chaos. Hopelessness and despair became pervasive.

On an international scale, people needed HOPE in 2021 like never before. The HOPE of a next meal for their family. The HOPE of medical supplies and medication. The HOPE of refuge from trafficking. The HOPE of support after a natural disaster. The HOPE of a Savior who promises a future where there will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain (Rev. 21:4).

Our mission is to inspire HOPE by connecting and empowering people to transform lives worldwide. If we were going to live out that mission in 2021 we were going to have to enter into pain and sadness and suffering right along with those who were experiencing it on a daily basis. So with the help of our Bold Hope family, and because we serve a God who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine (Eph. 3:20), we did. Hundreds of people prayed, served, and gave so that we could reach through the desperation to offer HOPE.

We raised over \$210,000 for medical care, trafficking prevention, discipleship programs, skills training, food distribution, and more. We supported partners in 15 countries. We sponsored nearly 250 children. But there is still more to be done because there are still billions who have not heard, who have no HOPE.

# **IMPACT: TRIPS**





"My sister and I joined Bold Hope on a mission trip to Belize. Our intentions were to serve God and his children. Belize taught us more than we could have ever imagined. While visiting the local school in the village of San Antonio we were greeted with big smiles from the sweetest children. Throughout the day we held VBS, played games with the children, and painted fingernails. There was one specific moment that will never leave my heart from that day. While I was walking around and talking to the children I looked over my shoulder, I saw my sister painting a little girl's nails. There is something so heartwarming and special about watching someone you love serve others through the love of God. What happened next is what blew me away... The little girl reached into a tiny pink purse and placed her last lollipop into my sister's hand and said, "this is for you". The little girl does not have a lot of material possessions but she does have a loving heart. Even when we don't have a lot of possessions if we have the love of God in our heart, we have enough. This special moment reminds me of the sacrifice that lesus made for us. Jesus gave his life for us when he died on the cross for our sins. I saw the love of God through this little girl, she taught me that the gift of giving is out of love. I am thankful for Bold Hope and for the experiences that they provide. Belize not only brought me out of my comfort zone but it brought me closer to God as well."



  - This is a huge deal for our stateside staff moving to paperless and having all of the information needed for trip participants uploaded into our system digitally is much more efficient




#### **AUGUST**


- New staff member

#### **OCTOBER**

- Denim & Diamonds Gala
  - Raised \$127,035 to help meet needs in the DR. This money will continue to support skills training, language learning, getting a sponsorship program up and running, and developing a ministry site.
- Weekly volunteers started serving in our stateside office
  - We are so grateful for volunteer support to help us with office tasks!



#### **DECEMBER**

- Savings Group Training (Microfinance Ministry) began in Haiti
  - This program will serve the families in our child sponsorship program.
- Upgrades to our trip system
  - Our financial, CRM, and website team worked hard to set up an automated system for receipt of trip payments!
- Finalized a trip training handbook for trip participants
  - We want to be sure to equip our trip participants to the best of our ability we hope this training handbook will mean they are better prepared for their time of serving.
- Marriages in Haiti
  - Our church had the opportunity to marry 7 couples over the course of 2021. This is an amazing testimony as marriage is often not a priority.
- End of Year Matching Campaign
  - Raised \$100,037.67 to help bridge our administrative gap of \$130,000.










In June of 2021, I took a group of graduating 12th grade students on a short mission trip to the Dominican Republic. These seniors had already experienced serving in their local church and in their community, so the goal for the mission trip was to allow them to "go into all the world" and serve in a different culture. One of our executive pastors and a few staff members also served on that mission trip. My entire group fell in love with people they served. Like many others who have served on a mission trip, my students went expecting to change lives but came back home having had their own lives changed from the experience. News of the excitement and the love these students had experienced traveled quickly through the high school, and the upcoming 12th grade students began asking if they could also serve in the same place for their senior mission trip. Our pastor enjoyed his experience so much that he decided our upcoming seniors and juniors should each sponsor a child in the place that they would visit on their senior mission trip, so our church graciously covered the costs for twenty-seven sponsored children. When school started this year, the pastor and I presented our juniors and seniors with the short bio and photo of their sponsored child that Bold Hope provided. The students were excited to immediately begin building a relationship with their sponsored child by writing their child a letter. My students were overjoyed when they received responses from the sponsored children, and they requested to be able to send small personal gifts and handwritten letters that could be personally delivered by me to the sponsored children when I visit their village in January. We decided that each of my juniors and seniors would create their own small bio to accompany their gift. This way, their sponsored child and their family could see who is communicating with them and praying for them. My students lift their sponsored children and families up in prayer every day in class. One of the most exciting things about these sponsorships is that my students will actually get to meet the children when they go on their senior mission trip. For my seniors, this is only a few short months away. For my juniors, they will have had two years of building relationships before they meet their sponsored child. I have sponsored children through other organizations, and I have never been so excited about a sponsorship program as am with this one! Legacy Academy hopes to have a long lasting relationship with Bold Hope!
